

Journal Cancellation Review – Comment Guidelines

The Library would like to obtain input on journal titles that subject librarians have identified for cancellation for three primary reasons:

1. To fund the purchase of new journals that will support new interdisciplinary initiatives or heavily refocused research or teaching programs
2. To identify potential budget reduction funds for potential mid-year or FY11 budget cuts
3. To support unfunded inflation

Comment Guidelines

We would appreciate substantive comments that faculty, students and staff may have related to retention decisions for the individual journals identified for cancellation. Comments of the following type would be most useful in helping us make final cancellation decisions:

- Your use of a particular journal in research
- A journal's centrality to your discipline ("core" journals)
- How you use a journal in a course
- A journal in which you frequently publish

If you have a comment or question regarding a particular journal, click on the specific title entry in the Title column of the Journal Cancellation list, and you will receive an e-mail template addressed to the Library with a subject line referencing the journal.
